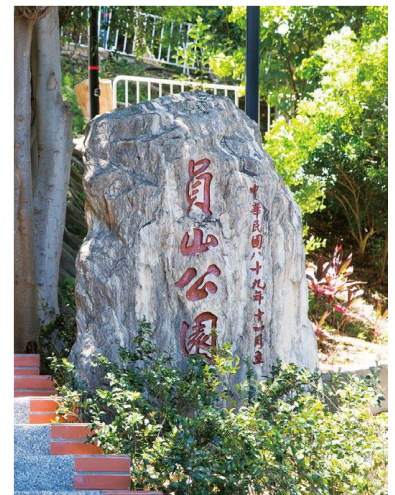
順著中和區員山路455 巷的

# Jisui History

**Waiyuan Mountain**, commonly known as **Jisui**, is a traditional locality in Zhonghe District, New Taipei City, Taiwan.

## History of Zhonghe

- **1684:** Fujian Province, Taiwan Circuit - Taiwan Prefecture, Zhuluo County
- **1723:** Fujian Province, Taiwan Circuit - Taiwan Prefecture, Tamsui Subprefecture, Tamsui Fort, Baijie Village
- **1895:** Taipei County, Tamsui Subprefecture - Baijie Fort governing 35 villages
- **1920:** Taipei State, Haishan District, Zhonghe Village
- **1946:** Taiwan Province, Taipei County, Haishan District, Zhonghe Township
- **1950:** Taiwan Province, Taipei County, Zhonghe Township
- **1958:** Taiwan Province, Taipei County, Zhonghe Township, Yonghe Town
- **1979:** Taiwan Province, Taipei County, Zhonghe City, Yonghe City
- **2010:** Taiwan Province, New Taipei City, Zhonghe District, Yonghe District

## Distant View of Yuanshan

Yuanshan, known today as **Jisui Yuanshanzi**, is a hill located in the northwestern part of Zhonghe. The name **Yuanshanzi** comes from the round and towering shape of the mountain. In the past, looking from **Yuanshanzi**, one could see vast rice fields, but now, the landscape has changed significantly, replaced by commercial buildings and high-rises.

At present, the summit of **Yuanshanzi** has been developed into **Yuanshan Park**. Following the **Lane 455 of Yuanshan Road, Zhonghe District**, one can find the park's entrance with a stairway leading into it. The park is equipped with a circular hiking trail, children's playground facilities, and a **Chinese-style pavilion**. Walking among the trees with a gentle breeze, chirping birds, and fragrant flowers creates a truly relaxing atmosphere.
